48 km (30 mi) northeast of Central London

From Stansted airport, the [Stansted Express](#) train is the fastest way into London, it runs regularly however it can also be a little pricey.

A cheaper option is to use one of the private coach/bus companies such as [TerraVision](#) or [National Express](#). Each of these will take you to **Liverpool Street Station** in the City.

Tube from Liverpool Street Station

To take the Tube you want the **Central Line** from Liverpool street to **Oxford Circus** where you make one change for the **Bakerloo Line** as far as **Lambeth North**.

Once you reach **Lambeth North** - exit the station turn right, cross the road and The Horse & Stables is on your right hand side!

Bus from Liverpool Street Station

Take the **344 bus** (which runs 24hrs) from nearby **Liverpool Street Station** on [Wormwood street](#). It will take you to within easy walking distance of the hostel. Get off at the stop for **The Imperial War Museum**.

From there following Kennington road (look for the Three Stags Pub) toward Westminster Bridge Road.

At the top pf the Kennington road you will see lambeth North Tube Station directly across the junction. The Horse & Stables is just to the left hand side.
